

CORRIGENDUM No 1

to the

Guidelines for grant applicants

Publication reference: GEAR/2017/394-354/SRB

Location: Serbia

The Guidelines for grant applicants are amended as follows:

Point No 5 – How to prepare and send project proposals

Instead of:

With the application package, the applicants must submit the following supporting documents:

- **A copy of the balance sheet and the profit and loss account⁴ of the organisation for 2017 and 2018 for the applicant;**

⁴ The certificate of the Tax Administration shall be submitted with the balance sheet and the profit and loss account

Read:

With the application package, the applicants must submit the following supporting documents (one printed copy):

- **A copy of the balance sheet and the profit and loss account of the organisation for 2017 and 2018 for the applicant.**

The obligation to submit the copies of the balance sheet and profit and loss accounts for 2017 does not apply for organisations established in 2018, and the obligation to submit the copies of the balance sheet and profit and loss account for 2017 and 2018 does not apply for organisations established in 2019 (and which fulfil the obligatory criterion of being established at least 6 months prior to the deadline for submission of project proposals).

Organisations which, due to justified reasons (in accordance with the national legislation) still do not have the final balance sheet and profit and loss account for 2018 shall submit the statistical balance sheet and profit and loss account for 2018. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for the financial statements (balance sheet and profit and loss account) where applicable, during the evaluation phase.

All other terms and conditions of the **Guidelines for grant applicants** remain unchanged. The above alterations and/or corrections to the Guidelines for grant applicants are integral part of the Application package published within the Call GEAR/2017/394-354/SRB.
